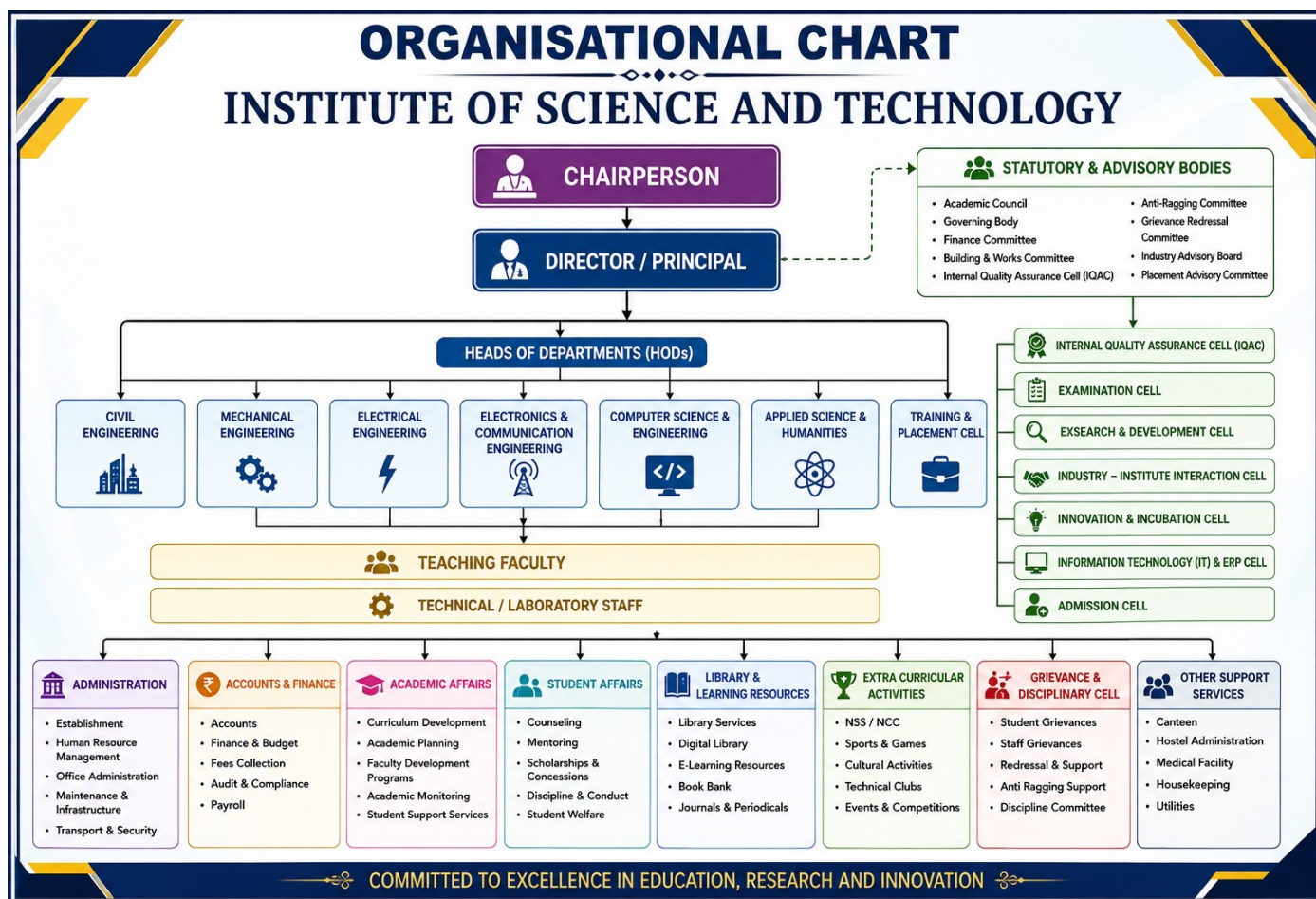

4. The Committee shall consider the grievance objectively and in accordance with the principles of natural justice.
5. Appropriate recommendations for resolution shall be submitted to the competent authority for necessary action.
6. The complainant shall be informed about the action taken/decision on the grievance within a reasonable period.
7. The Institution shall maintain appropriate records of grievances received and action taken, while maintaining confidentiality wherever required.
8. An aggrieved person who is not satisfied with the decision may approach the competent appellate authority/Ombudsperson, as applicable under the prevailing AICTE/University regulations.

The Institution ensures that no person shall be subjected to victimization or retaliation for submitting a genuine grievance in good faith.
